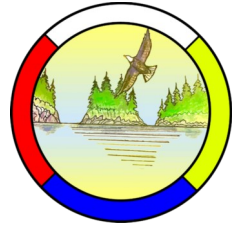

COMMUNITY CHECKPOINT INFORMATION SHEET

PURPOSE OF THE CHECKPOINT IS TO...

- ✓ Minimize risk factors for contracting the COVID-19 virus.
- ✓ Protect the health and safety of ALL community members that reside in Niisaachewan.
- ✓ Enforce NAN Pandemic Plan Safety Precautions and mitigate healthy alternatives.
- ✓ Ensure a safe environment for all high risk residents (immuno-compromised, elders, children).

POINTS TO REMEMBER?

1. Essential travel is restricted to Tuesday and Saturday's only. ALL TRIPS must be approved before exiting the community.
2. All business relating to checkpoint staff doing their job should be **effectively coordinated and organized ahead of time** to minimize inconvenience for both checkpoint staff and people exiting/entering the community. This includes appointments, and pick up/drop offs, along with any other issues relating to schedules, and Authorization Slips (Management Approvals).
3. All Documentation must be accurate and adequate prior to leaving and upon returning.
4. **THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE for any disruptive behavior towards checkpoint Staff. Any such behaviour will be taken seriously and dealt with accordingly. ALL Checkpoint Staff are FULLY supported by C&C.**
5. Checkpoint Staff reserve the right to contact the Police for any issues with non-compliance and/or disruptive/violent behaviour.

APPROACHING THE CHECKPOINT?

- ✓ Be prepared for a vehicle search, as well as being subjected to questionnaire screening.
- ✓ You **might** need to provide information to the workers to clarify Travel Approvals.
- ✓ Please be aware that Data Collection is being monitored at all times and is subject to change, alter, or halt any arrangements if flagged by Security Personnel at any time.
- ✓ Security Personnel are authorized to turn away traffic/travelers without proper documentation.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- ✓ Please respect ALL Security Personnel, any decisions, and Pandemic Precautionary Measures being implemented at this time.
 - ✓ **Refer to all Community Notices and Updates regarding our Current Regulations and Restrictions. If you need any copies or have questions, please advise a worker at the gate and they will provide info.**
 - ✓ Members travelling outside the Community are still highly encouraged to practice safe traveling, social distancing, sanitation, and are required to report any flu-like symptoms, travel outside Ontario, or isolation schedules **IMMEDIATELY** to on-duty Personnel, the Health Manager, or Chief and Council.
 - ✓ **Look out for one another, BE SAFE, and Miigwetch for your understanding and patience.**
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
