The following framework outlines the central/system programming opportunities for Summer 2021 at KPDSB.

A. Credit Recovery (VIRTUAL)		
June 28 - July 9	Current Gr. 9-12	All KP locations
<i>Students who have been recommended Credit Recovery for a course they were unsuccessful in and for which the summer programming teachers can support the achievement of the outlined expectations.</i>		
B. Cooperative Education (VIRTUAL and/or F2F)		
June 28 - August 20 (students may have different individual start/end dates)	Current Gr. 10-12	All KP locations
<i>Placements may be virtual or, if public health guidelines and supervision arrangements permit, face-to-face. Students may require summer Cooperative Education to meet their SHSM requirements or as a strategy to close credit gaps. Paid placements must meet defined criteria for credit. Pre-placement work will be required.</i>		
C. Individual and Family Living - HIF10 (VIRTUAL)		
June 28 - July 16	Current Gr. 8-10	All KP locations
<i>In a virtual collaborative model, students will participate in this blended synchronous/ asynchronous credit opportunity. Virtual sessions will run weekdays from 4-6PM. **Students who have achieved the HIF20 credit may not register for this course!</i>		
D. Civics and/or Careers - CHV20/GLC20 (VIRTUAL)		
June 28 - July 16	Current Gr. 9 - 12	All KP locations
<i>In a virtual collaborative model, students will participate in this blended synchronous/ asynchronous credit opportunity. Virtual sessions will run weekdays from 10-12PM AND 1-3PM. Students will attend both sessions.</i>		
E. KP 4 for 4 Camp (F2F and/or VIRTUAL)		
August 23 - 26	Current Gr. 8, new KP students	F2F - RL, Dry, Ken, SL Virtual - IG, Cro
<i>For 4 days, students will get ready 4 school with their 4D Coach 4 fun and 4 community service! In this transition to high school program, students will also participate in up to 20 hours of Community Involvement.</i>		
F. Full Credit Courses (VIRTUAL)		
June 28 - August 12 (M-Th)	Current Gr. 9-12	All KP locations
<i>Extended year programming for blended synchronous/asynchronous full credit courses will be approved based on specific criteria such as low credit accumulation and special programming needs.</i>		
G. Return to Learn Camp (F2F and/or VIRTUAL)		
August 9 - 19 (M-Th)	Current Gr. 7 and 8	All KP locations
<i>This will be a fun and exciting opportunity for participants to challenge their problem solving skills against real-world challenges and launch into a new school year. Students who require additional support in literacy or numeracy will participate in this full-day program to build skills required for success. A F2F option may be available in some locations, based on public health guidelines.</i>		
H. Individual School-Based Opportunities		
<i>Individual schools may also run additional extended year programming/summer school courses. Guidance Counsellors in these locations will have more information.</i>
